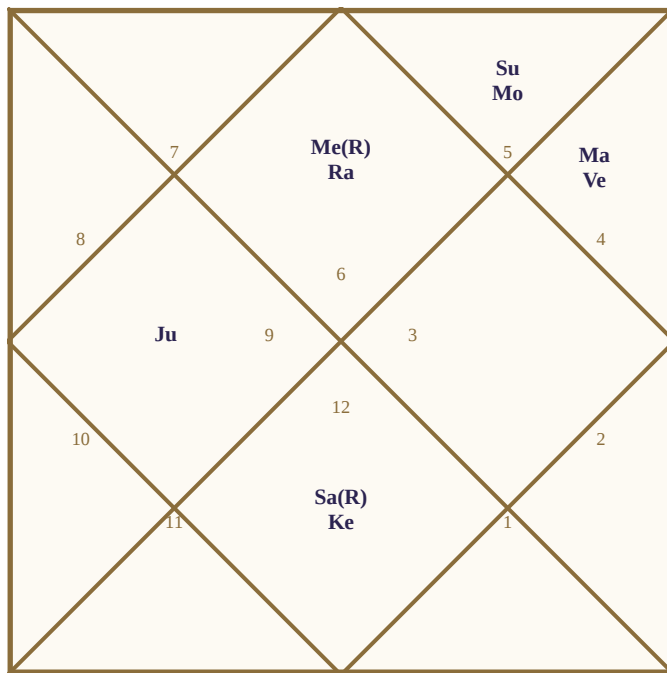

1. Career Foundation: Precision Over Visibility

Free, classical practices only — nothing here is for sale.

1. Wednesday discipline for Mercury

Recite the Budh (Mercury) beej mantra 'Om Bum Budhaya Namah' 108 times on Wednesday mornings, and avoid starting major decisions on that day until midday.

Your lagna lord Mercury is retrograde in the 1st house — strengthening it steadies the second-guessing this placement can produce.

2. Saturday restraint for Saturn

Observe a simple, self-imposed restraint each Saturday — skip one habitual indulgence (sugar, social media after a set hour, or similar) and, where possible, offer food or time to someone in service work.

Saturn rules your 6th and sits retrograde in the 7th — disciplined, quiet consistency on its day directly addresses the partnership patience this placement demands.

3. Written decisions, spoken once

Before any professional decision you have revised more than twice, write the final version down and state it aloud to one trusted colleague before acting on it.
